### **GD - Goal Defence**

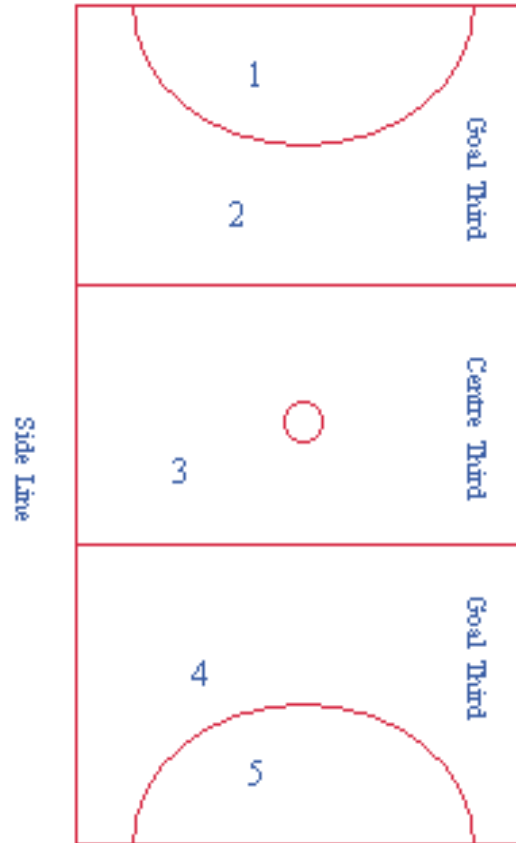
To win the ball and reduce the effectiveness of the GA
